



Environmental Handling Fees Class Action

A proposed settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit against Shoppers (d.b.a. "**Pharmaprix**") about prices advertised and charged by Pharmaprix in the province of Quebec for certain electronic products, such as batteries, subject to Environmental Handling Fees ("**EHFs**") it sold in Quebec (the "**Settlement Agreement**") (S.C.M. no 500-06-001243-233). The class action was based, essentially, on allegations that the price of products subject to EHF was not properly advertised.

To find out if you are a Class Member and how to exercise the options below, please read the long-form notice available by scanning the QR code below.

If approved by the Court, Pharmaprix will distribute the balance of the \$300,000.00 settlement amount (that is, after deducting class counsel's extrajudicial fees and expenses) in the form of a 50% discount on the regular price of batteries purchased in a Pharmaprix store during a ninety (90) day period or until the funds are depleted.

Class Members' Options

If you agree with the Settlement, you have nothing to do. You are part of the Class. If you wish to:

- **Opt-Out** of the Class, the deadline for doing so is **March 14, 2025**
- **Object** to the Settlement, the deadline for doing so is **March 14, 2025**
- **Attend the hearing**, it will take place on **March 20, 2025**, at the Montreal Court House, 1, Notre-Dame E., Montreal (Quebec), H2Y 1B6 and via a TEAMS.
