**APPLICATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A CLOSING JUDGMENT REGARDING
DEFENDANTS AMAZON.COM.CA ULC, AMAZON CANADA FULFILLMENT
SERVICES, INC., AMAZON.COM, INC. AND AMAZON.COM LLC**

(Art. 596 al. 3 CCP, art. 60 of the *Regulation of the Superior Court of Québec in civil matters*, CQLR c C-25.01, r 0.2.1, art. 42 of the *Act Respecting the Fonds d'aide aux actions collectives*, ch. F - 3.2.0.1.1, art. 1(1)(a) of the *Regulation respecting the percentage withheld by the Fonds d'aide aux actions collectives*, chapter F-3.2.0.1.1, r. 2, and section 130 of the Directives of the Superior Court – Montréal Division)

TO THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE PIERRE NOLLET OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF QUÉBEC, DESIGNATED JUDGE IN THE PRESENT CASE, THE DEFENDANTS AMAZON.COM.CA ULC, AMAZON CANADA FULFILLMENT SERVICES, INC., AMAZON.COM, INC. AND AMAZON.COM LLC RESPECTFULLY SUBMIT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Defendants Amazon.com.ca ULC, Amazon Canada Fulfillment Services, Inc., Amazon.com, Inc. and Amazon.com LLC (collectively, “**Amazon**”) hereby present their report on the claim process and seek the issuance of a closing judgment.
2. The present application is “partial”, in the sense that it covers only the Settlement between the representative plaintiff and Amazon, and not the other defendants to this class action (Wayfair LLC and Home Depot of Canada Inc.).

I. OVERVIEW

3. On July 26, 2022, the representative plaintiff Eva Bitton (the “**Plaintiff**”) filed an *Application to authorize the bringing of a class action and to appoint the status of representative plaintiff* against Amazon, Wayfair LLC and Home Depot of Canada Inc., which was subsequently amended and re-amended.
4. On August 10, 2023, this Court authorized the class action and identified the members of the Amazon class (the “**Amazon Class Members**”) as follows:

All consumers residing or domiciled in Quebec at the time of the purchase and who purchased an extended warranty on goods purchased from the Amazon mobile application(s) and/or website(s) between February 7, 2019 and April 17, 2023.

5. On December 22, 2023, Amazon and the Plaintiff entered into a settlement agreement (the “**Settlement**”) providing for a total settlement value of \$2,750,000 and allowing eligible Amazon Class Members to claim by March 12, 2024, a cash refund in the form of an Interac e-transfer representing up to 100% of the price they paid to purchase extended warranties from Amazon, excluding sales taxes.
6. On February 23, 2024, this Court approved the Settlement (*Bitton c. Amazon.com.ca (Amazon.com.ca, inc.)*, 2024 QCCS 1387) (the “**Settlement Approval Judgment**”).

7. As of March 12, 2024, Amazon Class Members had not submitted claims in sufficient numbers to deplete the settlement fund set up in accordance with the Settlement.
8. On May 6, 2024, at the request of the Plaintiff with the support of Amazon (both seeking to maximize the amounts to be paid out to Amazon Class Members), this Court, *inter alia*:
 - (a) extended the deadline for submitting a claim from March 12, 2024, to May 13, 2024;
 - (b) ordered the court-appointed Claims Administrator Concilia Services Inc. ("**Concilia**") to send additional notices by email to Amazon Class Members with the updated deadline; and
 - (c) declared that the word "exclusive" of sales taxes in the Settlement was replaced by "inclusive" of sales taxes.
9. Concilia proceeded to reopen and extend the claims deadline and sent an additional notice to Amazon Class Members.
10. As of May 13, 2024, Amazon Class Members had submitted 35,501 claims for a total value of \$1,672,055.75 (including sales taxes), as appears from Concilia's report on the extended period of the email campaign results and the settlement fund distribution results dated June 11, 2024, a copy of which is communicated herewith as **Exhibit A-1**.

II. CLASS COUNSEL FEES

11. This Court approved Class Counsel Fees of \$825,000 plus GST and QST in the Settlement Approval Judgment.
12. In accordance with the Settlement and on behalf of Amazon, the undersigned remitted the Class Counsel fees to Class Counsel on or around April 8, 2024.

III. THE DISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO THE SETTLEMENT

13. On November 25, 2024, Concilia issued a closing report detailing the final settlement fund distribution results (the "**Closing Report**"), a copy of which is communicated herewith as **Exhibit A-2**.
14. In accordance with the Settlement and on behalf of Amazon, the undersigned remitted \$1,801,456.25 to Concilia on May 5, 2024, to set up a settlement fund.
15. Concilia deducted its Claims Administrator's fees totalling \$187,466.99 from this amount. Following that deduction, the settlement fund totalled \$1,613,989.26 (the "**Settlement Amount**").
16. As noted above, Amazon Class Members submitted claims totalling CA\$1,672,055.75, resulting in a shortfall of \$58,066.49 as compared with the

Settlement Amount (Amazon Class Members having submitted claims are hereinafter referred to as “**Claimants**”).

17. In accordance with the Settlement, Concilia adjusted the settlement amounts to be distributed to Claimants (representing 100% of what they paid to buy the extended warranties including sales taxes), by a pro rata share of 3.43%.
18. On May 30, 2024, Concilia notified Claimants via email that their claims were approved and initiated the distribution of Interac e-Transfers to Claimants, who were provided with a 30-day period to accept their Interac e-Transfer.
19. As of the date of the Closing Report, a total of 35,501 Claimants received their compensation in the form of Interac e-Transfers, with a total of 28,973 out of 35,501 successful deposits (81.61%), totaling **\$1,398,372.29** in total deposited payments.
20. Additionally, Concilia issued 23 cheques to Claimants who demonstrated that they were unable to deposit their e-transfers and requested this form of payment.
21. As of the date of the Closing Report, all 23 cheques had been deposited, for a total value of **\$4,294.23**.
22. Following the distribution, a balance (*reliquat*) of **\$211,322.74** remains from the Settlement Amount and is being kept in trust by the undersigned on behalf of Amazon, as provided for in clause 41 of the Settlement.
23. From this balance, an amount of **\$147,925.92** (representing 70% in accordance with article 1(1)(c) of the *Regulation respecting the percentage withheld by the Fonds d'aide aux actions collectives*) will be remitted to the *Fonds d'aide aux actions collectives*.
24. For the remaining balance of \$63,396.82, the parties jointly submit to the Court that it should be divided equally and remitted to the following two charitable organizations, in accordance with clause 41 of the Settlement, and pursuant to the email sent to the Court on October 16, 2024, by Counsel for the Defendants:
 - (a) The Montreal Children's Hospital Foundation, to be placed into and used towards the “*P.K. Subban Foundation*”, registered under charity number 800699910 RR 0001 to receive **\$31,698.41** (50%); and
 - (b) The Jewish General Hospital Foundation, the latter amount to be dedicated to supporting the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), registered under charity number 104872304 RR 0001 to receive the remaining **\$31,698.41** (50%).
25. On May 27, 2026, The Montreal Children's Hospital marked the fulfillment of a \$10 million commitment towards assisting “*families facing serious financial issues because of their child's illness*”, as it appears from The Montreal Children's Hospital's website, filed herewith as **Exhibit A-3**, along with the *P.K. Subban Foundation's* Registered Charity Information page from the government of Canada's website, filed herewith as **Exhibit A-4**;

26. As it appears from *The Jewish General Hospital Foundation's* Registered Charity Information page from the government of Canada's website, filed herewith as **Exhibit A-5**, its ongoing programs include "*to raise funds for hospital research and development in the fields of medicine, surgery and related hospital activities*";
27. The Montreal Children's Hospital Foundation and the Jewish General Hospital Foundation notably help finance high-quality healthcare for infants and children and thereby provide tangible public benefits to consumers and families in Quebec. They are appropriate charities to support in the context of the present consumer class action.
28. Accordingly, following the issuance of the closing judgment sought herein, the undersigned will pay, from the remaining balance held in trust, \$147,925.92 to the *Fonds d'aide aux actions collectives*, \$31,698.41 to The Montreal Children's Hospital Foundation to be placed into and used towards the "*P.K. Subban Foundation*" and \$31,698.41 to Jewish General Hospital Foundation (Neonatal Intensive Care Unit), thereby fully completing the distribution of the funds under the Settlement.

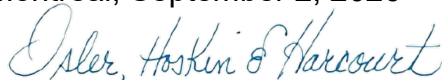
IV. CONCLUSION

29. Considering the above, Amazon is well founded in fact and in law to seek a closing judgment with regard to its involvement in the present class action.

Settlement Fund Distribution Results

November 25, 2024



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1. SETTLEMENT FUND ADJUSTMENT SUMMARY

The total amount available for distribution is \$1,613,989.26 CAD. However, the total amount being claimed is \$1,672,055.75 CAD. As per paragraph 38 (a) of the Settlement Agreement, the settlement amounts were adjusted downwards by a pro rata share of 3.43%. Consequently, each Refund Eligible Class Member received the total amount, including sales tax, of what they paid minus 3.43%.

Please refer to the table in section 2 of this report for a detailed breakdown of the Settlement Fund distribution.

1.1. INTERAC ETRANSFER DISTRIBUTION RESULTS

On May 30, 2024, Concilia notified Claimants via email that their claims had been approved and advised them to anticipate their refunds. The email included a unique 4-digit password for secure fund deposits.

On the same day, Concilia initiated the distribution of Interac® e-Transfers. These transfers, sent directly from Interac®, allowed recipients to conveniently deposit the funds into their bank accounts. Each recipient was given 30 days to accept the e-Transfer, with reminder emails sent every 5 days.

A total of 35,501 Refund Eligible Class Members received their payouts in the form of Interac® e-Transfers. Annex 1 contains a copy of the email with the password, while Annex 2 showcases a sample of the Interac® e-Transfer email.

As of the date of this report, 28,973 out of 35,501 transfers have been successfully deposited, totaling \$ 1,398,372.29 CAD out of the \$ 1,613,989.26 CAD available for distribution.

1.2. CHEQUE DISTRIBUTIONS

Concilia has issued cheques to 23 claimants who demonstrated that they were unable to deposit their e-transfers and requested this form of payment. The cheques,



totaling \$ 4,294.23 CAD, have been mailed out to the claimants. As of the date of this report all cheques have been deposited.
