Subject: Notice of Authorization of a Class Action by the Québec Superior Court

DO NOT REPLY – This is an automated message.

We are contacting you in accordance with the Superior Court of Québec judgment dated September 2, 2025 (case number 500-06-001291-240) which authorized a class action against Cineplex Inc. and Cineplex Entertainment Limited Partnership (hereinafter the “**Defendants**”).

The Plaintiff alleges that the Defendants failed to properly disclose online booking fees charged for the purchase of movie tickets via www.cineplex.com or the Cineplex mobile application, in alleged violation of the provisions of the *Consumer Protection Act* and the *Competition Act*.

The Defendants vigorously deny these allegations. The court has not yet decided whether Mr. Ponton’s claim is well-founded, and the allegations made in the class action have not yet been proven. A trial will be held at a later date to allow the parties to present their evidence and arguments.

You are a member of the class action if you purchased a movie ticket using the www.cineplex.com website or the Cineplex mobile application for a movie at a theatre located in the Province of Québec between June 15, 2022 and December 12, 2024, and you paid online booking fees for that purchase.

Please read carefully the detailed Notice of Authorization of a Class Action available [here](#). The class action claims compensatory and punitive damages or, alternatively, a reduction of the purchase price.

You may opt out of the class action by sending a letter to the Clerk of the Superior Court of Québec (mentioning the case number above), as described in more detail in the Notice of Authorization of a Class Action available [here](#).

The deadline to opt out of the class action is **April 24, 2026**.
