OPPOSITION OF THE APPLICANT TO THE DECLARATION OF INTERVENTION
(ARTICLE 186 AL.2 C.C.P.)

**TO: Mtre Eric Prefontaine
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1. The Applicant, Harley Nadler, hereby opposes the “*Acte d'intervention à titre conservatoire au soutien de la suspension de l'instance*”, as specified in said declaration notified by the Intervenor, Kris Mangion, on April 14, 2026, for the reasons set forth below;
2. Mr. Mangion is not a Class Member in present class action and therefore has no standing whatsoever to make any representations before this Honourable Court;

3. Moreover, it is highly irregular and inappropriate for Mr. Mangion, the proposed representative in a class action in a foreign jurisdiction, to ask this Court to support the conclusions sought by the same Defendants who he is suing;
4. In reality, Mr. Mangion is bringing forward a disguised carriage motion and entirely disregards article 577 C.C.P. As such his “intervention” constitutes an abuse of process;
5. Mr. Mangion purports to act in the best interest of Quebec Class Members, however article 586 C.C.P. expressly stipulates that a class member cannot intervene voluntarily for the plaintiffs except to **assist** the representative plaintiff or to **support** the representative plaintiff’s application or contentions. Mr. Mangion, on the other hand, is acting – with the Defendants – against Mr. Nadler;
6. Lastly, Mr. Mangion’s certification hearing is scheduled to take place over 1 year from now, i.e. May 17, 2027, whereas Mr. Nadler is prepared to proceed to authorization immediately.
