(Article 574 CCP)

TO THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE YIANNAKIS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF QUEBEC, SITTING IN AND FOR THE DISTRICT OF MONTREAL, DEFENDANT KENTUCKY FRIED CHICKEN CANADA COMPANY RESPECTFULLY SUBMITS THE FOLLOWING:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Defendant Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company (“**KFC**”) seeks leave to adduce relevant and limited evidence in order to establish facts that are necessary to enable this Court to undertake an informed analysis, in light of the criteria set out in article 575 of the *Code of Civil Procedure* (the “**CCP**”) regarding the authorization sought by Plaintiff to institute class action proceedings against the Defendants.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On or around November 7, 2025, Plaintiff filed an *Application for authorization to institute a class action and to obtain the status of representative*, as appears from the record of this Honourable Court (the “**Application**”).
3. As appears from paragraph 20 of the Application, Plaintiff seeks authorization to institute a class action on behalf of the following group and sub-group:

Tous les consommateurs au sens de la Loi sur la protection du consommateur au Québec qui, depuis le 7 novembre 2022, ont effectué une commande de repas livré via le site internet ou les applications mobiles de l'une des Défenderesses et ont payé un prix supérieur (en raison de frais ajoutés obligatoires) au prix initialement annoncé ou indiqué pour pouvoir compléter leur commande.

ou tout autre membre tel que déterminé par la Cour;

*(lesquels étant ci-après désignés les « **Membres du groupe** » ou le « **Groupe** »);*

Comportant le sous-groupe suivant :

Tous les consommateurs au sens de la Loi sur la protection du consommateur au Québec qui, depuis le 7 novembre 2022, ont effectué une commande de repas livré via le site internet ou les applications mobiles de l'une des Défenderesses utilisant la plateforme UEAT de CORPORATIONS SOLUTIONS MONERIS et qui ont payé un prix supérieur (en raison de frais ajoutés obligatoires) au prix initialement annoncé ou indiqué pour pouvoir compléter leur commande.

*(ci-après le « **Sous-groupe Moneris** »)*

4. Plaintiff alleges that Defendants' commercial practice of advertising an initial price for a meal delivery order that is purportedly incomplete, fragmentary, partial, and unattainable, and then demanding and charging a higher price at the end due to additional delivery fees, is illicit.
5. Further, Plaintiff alleges that this commercial practice contravenes the *Consumer Protection Act* (the "**CPA**") and the *Competition Act*.
6. Consequently, Plaintiff, who claims to have suffered harm as a result of this commercial practice, seeks to have Defendants condemned to pay a sum as loss or damage, or as reduction of the obligation or compensatory damages, or alternatively the nullity of contracts.
7. In addition, Plaintiff seeks punitive damages on behalf of the Group in the amount of \$1,000,000 to \$5,000,000 from each Defendant depending on their size.
8. The common questions put forward by the Plaintiff are the following:
 - (a) *Est-ce que les défenderesses chargent un frais de livraison?*
 - (b) *Est-ce que les défenderesses ont inclus le frais de livraison dans toutes leurs représentations de prix?*

- (c) *Les défenderesses ont-elles contrevenu à l'article 224(c) de la LPC?*
- (d) *Les défenderesses ont-elles contrevenu aux l'article 219 et 228 de la LPC?*
- (e) *Les défenderesses ont-elles contrevenu à l'article 52, 52(1.1) et 52(1.3) de la Loi sur la concurrence?*
- (f) *Les membres du groupe ont-ils droit :*
 - (i) *à la nullité des contrats, à une réduction de leur obligation ou des dommages compensatoires sous la L.p.c.;*
 - (ii) *au recouvrement de leur perte économique ou dommages subis découlant du comportement des défenderesses? (art. 36 Loi sur la concurrence)*
 - (iii) *au recouvrement des honoraires d'avocats pour l'enquête et les procédures engagées? (art. 36 Loi sur la concurrence)*
 - (iv) *à un montant allant de 1 000 000\$ à 5 000 000\$, selon la taille de la défenderesse, en dommages punitifs par défenderesse; et/ou*
 - (v) *à l'intérêt et indemnité additionnelle prévue par le Code civil du Québec sur ces montants, à compter de la date du dépôt de la demande d'autorisation?*

Et pour les membres du Sous-groupe Moneris :

- (a) *La défenderesse CORPORATION SOLUTIONS MONERIS est-elle un participant, au sens de l'art. 21(1)b) C. Cr., aux infractions sous les articles 52, 52(1.1) et 52(1.3) de la Loi sur la concurrence?*
- (b) *Les membres du groupe ont-ils droit au recouvrement contre CORPORATION SOLUTIONS MONERIS de :*
 - (i) *leur perte économique ou dommages subis découlant du comportement des défenderesses? (art. 36 Loi sur la concurrence)*
 - (ii) *au recouvrement des honoraires d'avocats pour l'enquête et les procédures engagées? (art. 36 Loi sur la concurrence)*

9. The Application contains certain vague and imprecise allegations. Therefore, KFC seeks leave from this Court to adduce relevant evidence in order to rectify incorrect allegations and to correct facts that are necessary for the purposes of the authorization hearing.

III. EVIDENCE PROPOSED BY KFC

10. The evidence which KFC seeks leave to adduce consists of a sworn statement of Ryan Fisher, Martech Product Manager at KFC, covering the following topics:
 - (a) A concise overview of KFC franchises, including KFC's role as franchisor;
 - (b) A general description of the purpose of the delivery fees and their determination;
 - (c) A general description of changes to KFC's ordering platforms;
 - (d) A description of the current ordering process on KFC's website and mobile application; and
 - (e) Details regarding the fact that KFC's internal records demonstrate that the Plaintiff is not the individual who placed the order that is at issue in the Application;

as appears from the draft sworn statement of Ryan Fisher communicated herewith as **Exhibit R-1** (the "**Sworn Statement**").

11. KFC also seeks leave to adduce an exhibit in support of the Sworn Statement to demonstrate that the Plaintiff is not the individual who placed the order that is at issue in the Application, namely the Order Details Spreadsheet, Exhibit RF-1 in support of the Sworn Statement.

IV. GROUNDS IN SUPPORT OF THE PRESENT APPLICATION

12. The evidence which KFC seeks leave to adduce is eminently relevant and appropriate to the authorization inquiry proposed by the Plaintiff.
13. It appears from the Application that the Court does not have sufficient information to render judgment in light of the criteria set forth in article 575 CCP, and therefore KFC should be authorized to submit the additional evidence referred to above.
14. Notably, at paragraphs 5 to 10, 22 to 45 and 104 to 106 of the Application, Plaintiff discusses KFC's customer journey for placing online orders for delivery.
15. Specifically, at paragraph 105 of the Application, Plaintiff simply states that "*PFK contrôle et exploite le site transactionnel <https://www.kfc.ca/>*".
16. The Sworn Statement would enable KFC to bring more precision to the allegations made by Plaintiff in this regard. Notably, the Sworn Statement addresses the determination of delivery fees, clarifying that KFC is not involved in this process and that it is rather the franchisees that determine the applicable delivery fees.

17. The Sworn Statement also addresses changes that were implemented to KFC's online ordering platforms, including the www.kfc.ca website and the mobile application, and describes the current ordering process on KFC's platforms.
18. The Sworn Statement indicates that March 25, 2026 is the latest date by which all orders have been processed exclusively through the updated website and mobile application.
19. The updates to KFC's online ordering platforms, combined with the implementation date, are especially important in assisting the Court in determining the end date for the class period.
20. Further, at paragraphs 24 and following of the Application, Plaintiff describes the ordering process that he followed for placing the order at issue in the Application.
21. However, as mentioned, KFC's internal records indicate that the Plaintiff is not the individual who placed the order discussed in the Application. Rather, KFC's internal records demonstrate that the order was placed under the name of an individual named Rhaya Rozayy, which challenges Plaintiff's standing as proposed representative of the Group.
22. As such, the Sworn Statement will notably assist the Court in assessing criteria (2) and (4) of article 575 CCP, as the Plaintiff, if he did not place the order at issue in the Application and merely provided payment for it, cannot have been directly exposed to the alleged commercial practices. As a result, the Plaintiff does not qualify as an appropriate representative for the class. Moreover, the conclusions sought are not justified by the facts alleged, given that the Plaintiff did not personally experience the alleged commercial practices.
23. In sum, the Sworn Statement along with its supporting Exhibit RF-1 are relevant and useful to the Court in that they briefly set out various considerations that must be understood by the Court in order to assess the circumstances at hand, particularly with regard to the activities of KFC, the delivery fees, the ordering process at issue which has undergone changes after the filing of the Application, and the identity of the individual who placed the KFC delivery order discussed in the Application.
24. The Sworn Statement along with its supporting Exhibit RF-1 will allow to streamline the authorization hearing by providing precision and clarity on the issues of fact and law alleged by the Plaintiff. It will address and rectify certain ambiguities and generalities contained in the Application and ensure an accurate examination of the criteria for authorization.
25. KFC's application to adduce evidence is necessary to enable this Court to fully understand the nature of this class action and to allow KFC to mount a balanced, informed challenge to the authorization criteria.

26. The Sworn Statement is succinct and limited in scope; it is thus consistent with the nature of the authorization process and the principle of proportionality.

WHEREFORE MAY IT PLEASE THIS COURT TO:

GRANT the present *Application by Defendant Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company for Leave to Adduce Relevant Evidence*;

AUTHORIZE Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company to file the sworn statement of Ryan Fisher and Exhibit RF-1 in support thereof;

ALL OF WHICH IS REQUESTED without costs, except in case of contestation.

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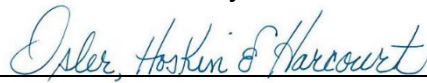

SWORN STATEMENT OF RYAN FISHER

I, the undersigned, Ryan Fisher, Martech Product Manager at Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company, having its principal place of business at 191 Creditview Road, Suite 100, Vaughan ON, L4L 9T1, solemnly affirm the following:

I. KFC FRANCHISES AND DELIVERY FEES

1. Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company is the franchisor of the KFC system, providing franchisees with the KFC brand and trademarks, as well as the proprietary concept, operating methods, and support services necessary for the operation of KFC restaurants in Canada, which are owned and operated by independent franchisees.
2. The services offered by Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company to its franchisees include access to a platform (website and mobile application) to direct customer orders placed online based on various parameters, including the franchisee's participation in the platform, location, time, availability and customer traffic.
3. When placing an order online, a customer must determine whether they wish to pick up their order at the designated KFC restaurant, or if they wish to have the order delivered to the location of their choice, in which case delivery fees apply for the delivery service offered by the franchisee.
4. The delivery fees represent the consideration for the service offered to the customer for the delivery of their order. Delivery fees are for the benefit of the franchisee to compensate in whole or in part for the costs they incur in offering

this service, through their employees, self-employed workers or delivery partners, as applicable.

5. It is not possible for Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company to determine the purpose, context or occasion of the orders placed by customers through its website or mobile application.

II. DETERMINATION OF DELIVERY FEES

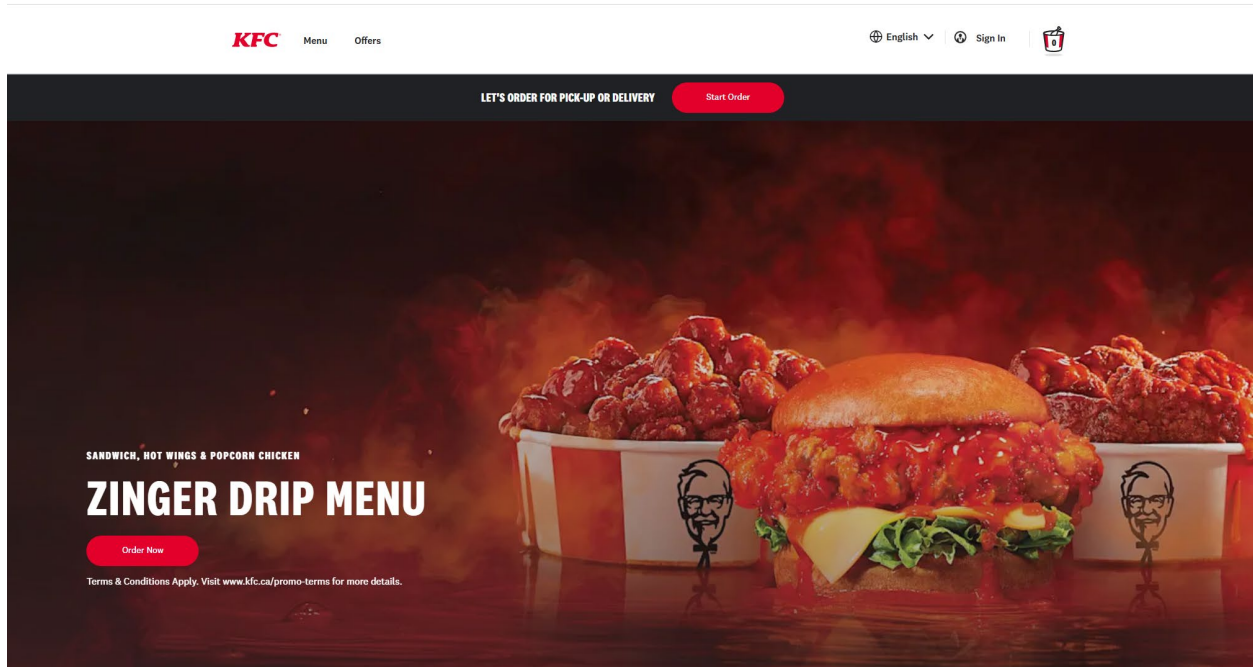
6. Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company operates www.kfc.ca through a third-party platform, Cognizant Technology Solutions Canada Inc. (“**Cognizant**”).
7. Each franchisee is responsible for determining the delivery fee applicable to orders that it delivers, notably by working directly with a Delivery as a Service (DaaS) provider, such as Uber Eats.
8. Neither Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company nor Cognizant is involved in setting or determining the delivery fees applicable to orders placed online by customers for delivery.

III. CHANGES TO THE ORDERING PLATFORMS

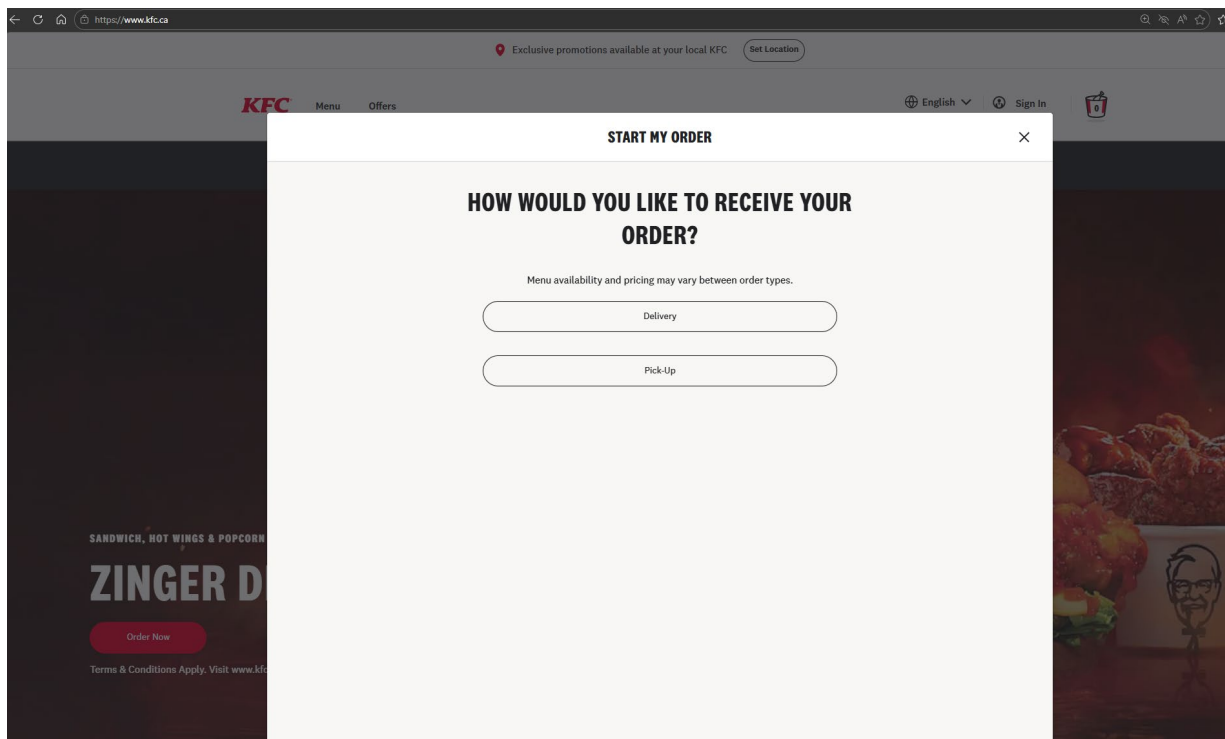
9. On or around January 23, 2026, Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company began implementing changes to update and improve its online ordering platforms, including the www.kfc.ca website and the mobile application.
10. As of March 18, 2026, the updated website became completely operational.
11. Further, as of March 25, 2026, the updated mobile application became completely operational.
12. Therefore, as of March 25, 2026, at the latest, all orders placed with Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company have been processed exclusively through the updated website and the updated mobile application.
13. In particular, the updated website and the updated mobile application include two key features, namely:
 - a) After a customer enters their delivery address, they are prompted to select a restaurant for delivery. The delivery fee is visible prior to selecting the restaurant; and
 - b) After a customer selects the restaurant, the delivery fee is visible throughout the ordering journey on the information banner.
14. The following section describes, in further detail and with images, the online ordering process that has been in place since March 25, 2026.

IV. CURRENT ONLINE ORDER PROCESS

15. When a customer visits the www.kfc.ca website, they must click on “Start Order”, as appears from a screenshot below:



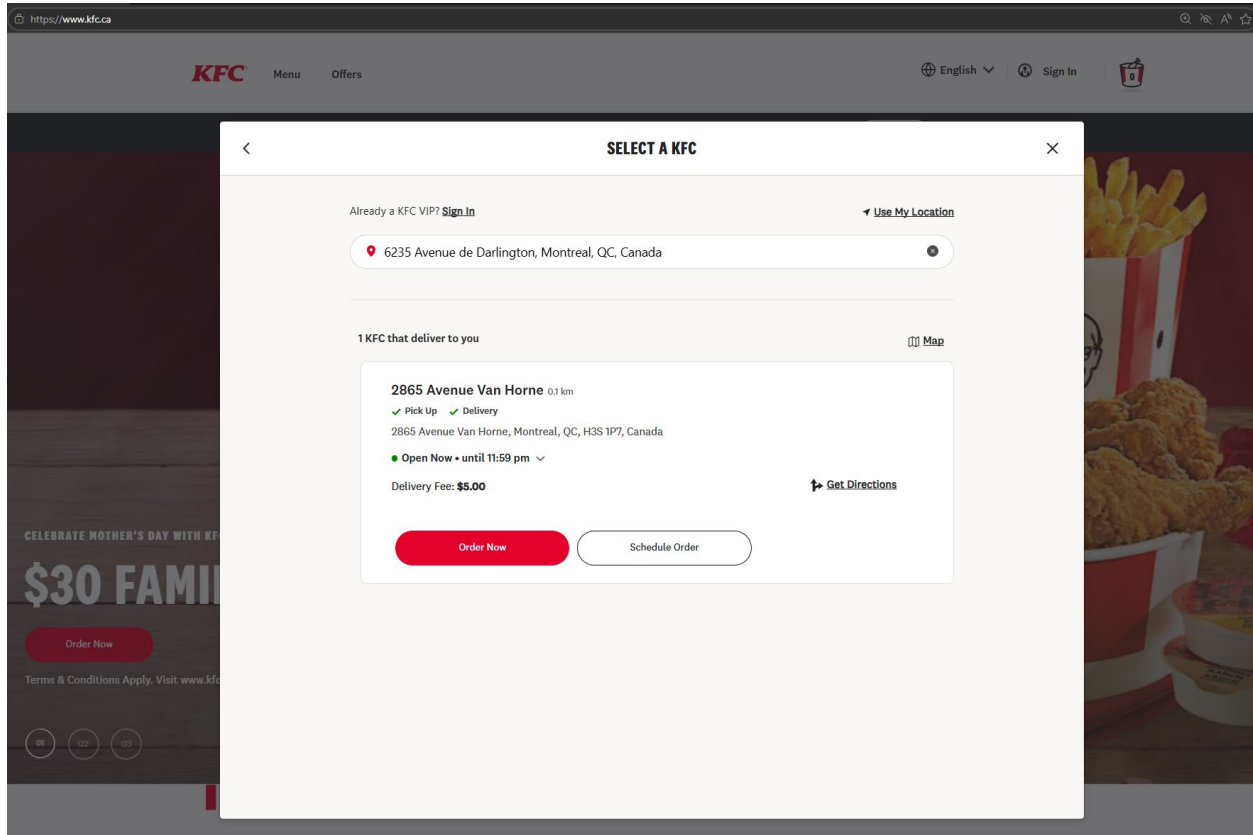
16. The customer is then prompted to indicate how they would like to receive their order, i.e., delivery or pick-up, with a mention indicating that “Menu availability and pricing may vary between order types,” as appears from a screenshot below:



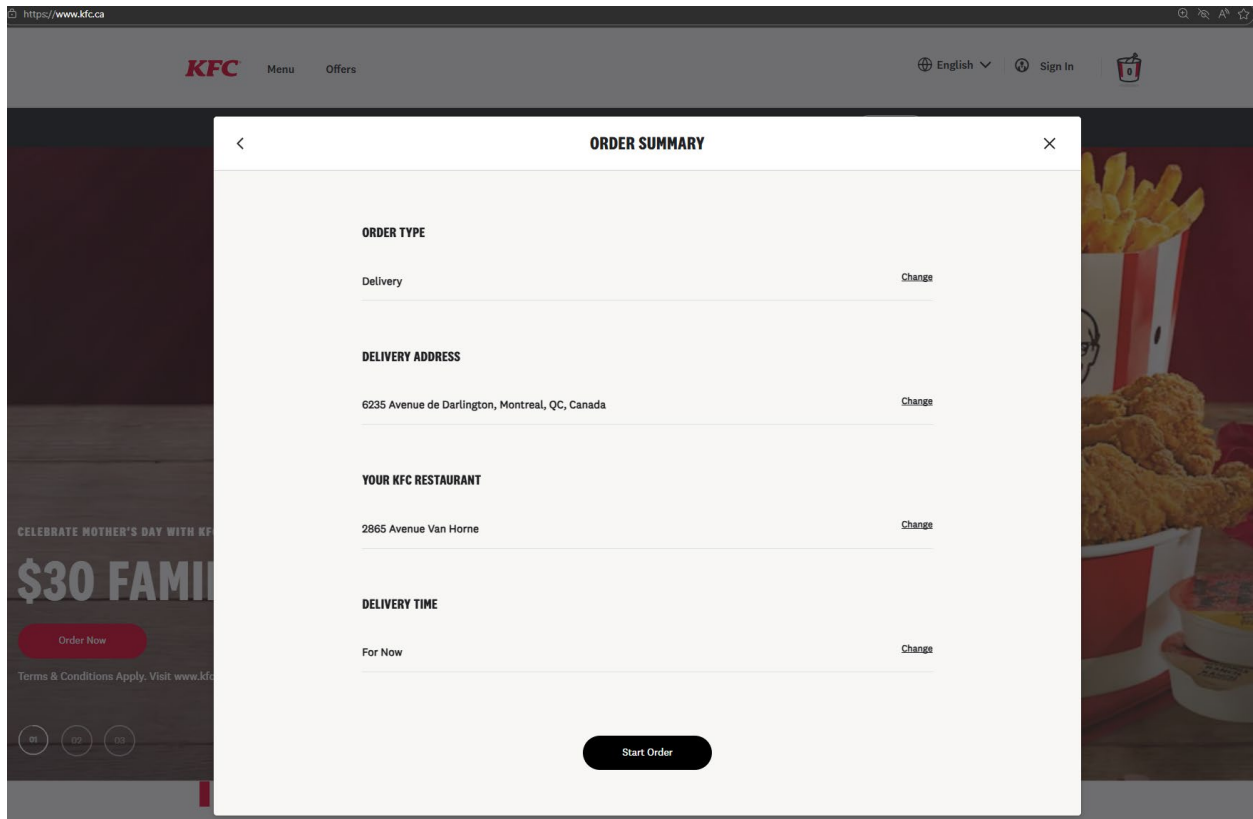
17. When choosing “Delivery”, the customer is prompted to enter their delivery address, as appears from a screenshot below:

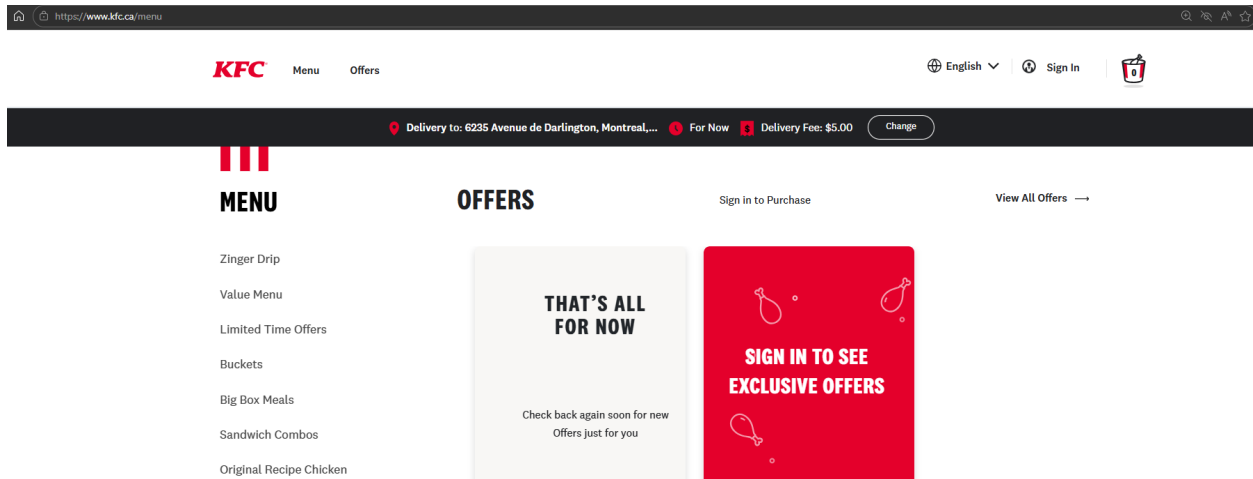
18. As soon as the customer confirms the delivery address, the applicable delivery fee is automatically displayed under the address of the KFC store that will deliver the order, as appears from a screenshot below. The address referenced in paragraph 7 of the Application for Authorization and in Plaintiff's Exhibits P-2 and P-4 is used for the purposes of this example.



19. Then, clicking on “Order Now” brings the customer to an order summary page, after which the customer may click on “Start Order”, as appears from a screenshot below:



20. This directs the customer to KFC’s menu, and from then on, the delivery fee is displayed in a black banner at the top of the webpage throughout the entire customer journey, as appears from a screenshot below:



21. When clicking on an item to view it, the delivery fee continues being displayed in the black banner at the top of the webpage, as appears from a screenshot below using the KFC Famous Chicken Sandwich as an example:

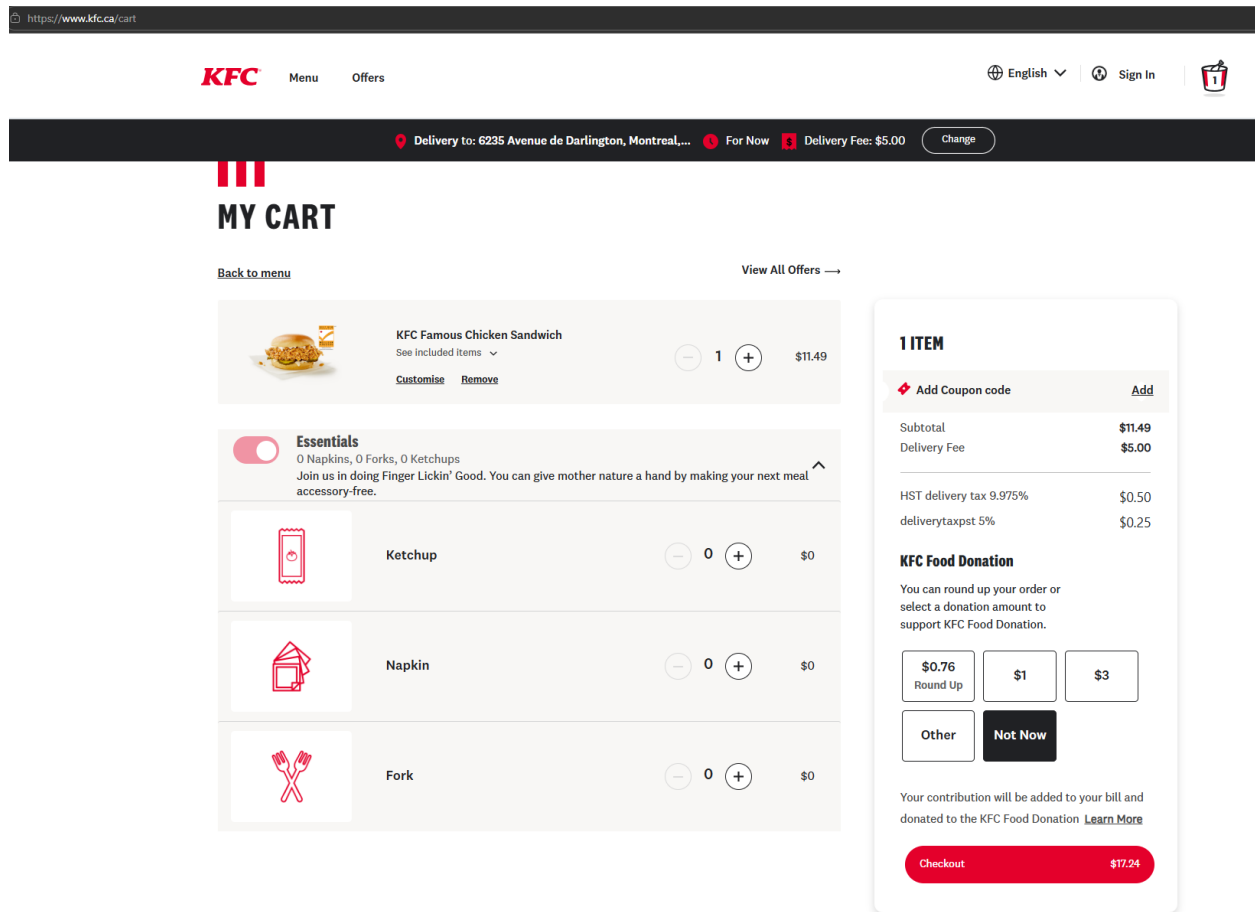

24. The “Checkout” amount displayed in the lower right-hand corner of the page includes the delivery fee and applicable taxes.

25. Lastly, when clicking the “Checkout” button, the customer is brought to the next page where they are prompted to enter their contact and payment information, and where the delivery fee is displayed above the total amount to be paid, as appears from a screenshot below:

26. This process would be the same for any item ordered on Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company’s website or mobile application – the delivery fee appears at every step of placing an online order for delivery.

V. PLAINTIFF’S DELIVERY ORDER

27. Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company’s internal records demonstrate that the proposed representative, Brandyn Reddick, is not the person who placed the delivery order underlying the Application for Authorization.
28. Rather, Kentucky Fried Chicken Canada Company’s internal records demonstrate that the order underlying the Application for Authorization was placed under the name of Rhaya Rozayy, as appears from the Order Details Spreadsheet, **Exhibit RF-1**, of which partial screenshots are included below:
