JUDGMENT APPROVING THE SUSPENSION OF THE PUBLICATION NOTICES

- [1] **CONSIDERING** that on January 27, 2020, the Court granted the Representative Plaintiff's *Application for Approval of Notices to Class Members of a Settlement Approval Hearing* and approved the notice plan (the "**Notice Plan**" or "**Plan de Notification**");¹
- [2] **CONSIDERING** that the Notice Plan required the Defendant to post notices, *inter alia*, in its restaurants in Quebec for a period of 30 days commencing no later than April 15, 2020;
- [3] **CONSIDERING** the global health pandemic resulting from the novel coronavirus ("**COVID-19**") necessitates suspension of the Notice Plan previously approved by the Court;

[4] **CONSIDERING** the written request made by the parties on March 18, 2020, asking the Court to suspend the Notice Plan in order to take COVID-19 into account;

- [5] **CONSIDERING** the request made by counsel to the Representative Plaintiff regarding an advance payment of a portion of Class Counsel Fees and of disbursements incurred, as well as Class Counsel's undertaking to reimburse these sums to the Defendant should the settlement not be approved;
- [6] **CONSIDERING** that it is in the interest of justice to grant the parties' applications made on March 18, 2020;
- [7] **CONSIDERING** articles 25, 49, 580, 581 and 590 of the *Code of Civil Procedure*;

FOR THESE REASONS, THE COURT:
