APPLICATION TO AUTHORIZE A CLASS ACTION FOR SETTLEMENT PURPOSES ONLY, FOR APPROVAL OF NOTICE TO CLASS MEMBERS OF A SETTLEMENT APPROVAL HEARING AND TO APPOINT A CLAIMS ADMINISTRATOR (Sections 101, 575, 576, 579, 580, 581, and 590 C.C.P.)

TO THE HONORABLE JUSTICE PIERRE-C. GAGNON OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF QUEBEC, DISTRICT OF MONTREAL, DESIGNATED TO PRESIDE OVER THE PRESENT CLASS ACTION, THE PLAINTIFF RESPECTFULLY SUBMITS THE FOLLOWING:

I. NATURE OF THE APPLICATION

- 1. In May 2021, Plaintiff entered into a settlement in principle with Defendant SeatGeek, Inc. (hereinafter "SeatGeek") regarding all persons in Quebec who purchased before March 11, 2020 at least one or more Tickets from SeatGeek to at least one or more events scheduled to take place after March 11, 2020, which events were subsequently either postponed or rescheduled. The settling parties continued their negotiations for many months thereafter, ultimately arriving at a formal transaction agreement in March 2022, the whole as appears more fully from a copy of the Settlement Agreement entitled "Transaction Agreement", communicated herewith as Exhibit R-1, together with its schedules and French translation (the "Settlement Agreement" or the "Transaction").
- This Application is for an order authorizing the bringing of a class action for settlement purposes only, approving the notices to class members for the settlement approval hearing and appointing the Notice Administrator.



- 3. Pursuant to paragraphs 26 and 27 of the Settlement Agreement, the Parties jointly request to obtain the Court's authorization of the class action for the Settlement Class as defined below.
- 4. Except to the extent they are modified by this Application, the definitions set out in the Settlement Agreement apply and are incorporated herein.

II. BACKGROUND

5. On July 10, 2020, Plaintiff filed its *Amended Application for Authorization to Institute a Class Action* against multiple Defendants including SeatGeek, before the Superior Court of Québec, District of Montreal, on behalf of the following proposed class:

All persons in Canada, who purchased before March 11, 2020 one or more tickets from one of the Defendants for an event scheduled to take place after March 11, 2020, which event was subsequently either postponed, rescheduled or cancelled, without a full refund being timely provided by Defendants, or any other Group(s) or Sub-Group(s) to be determined by the Court;

- 6. This action arises from the refusal by multiple first and second market event ticket providers to provide refunds to consumers shortly after the March 2020 Covid-19 pandemic was declared, regarding events which were either cancelled, rescheduled or postponed due to the Covid-19 restrictions.
- This Transaction Agreement concerns the Defendant SeatGeek, Inc. only, and only relates to events which were postponed or rescheduled without a refund being provided by SeatGeek.
- 8. After many months of negotiations, the Parties have now reached a complete Transaction Agreement.



III. AUTHORIZATION FOR SETTLEMENT PURPOSES ONLY

 Defendant SeatGeek consents to the authorization of the bringing of a class action on behalf of the following amended <u>Quebec only class</u>, solely for settlement purposes and without any admission (the "Settlement Class Member"):

"All persons in <u>Quebec</u>, who purchased before March 11, 2020 one or more tickets from <u>SeatGeek</u> for an event scheduled to take place after March 11, 2020, which event was subsequently either postponed <u>or</u> rescheduled, without a full refund being provided by SeatGeek;"

10. In this regard, and considering SeatGeek's policy to offer to users holding Tickets to events that were cancelled (as opposed to postponed or rescheduled) a refund in cash or a credit, at their discretion, the definition of Eligible Members under the settlement is more fully described at Section II. (s) of the Transaction Agreement.

1- The Claims of the Settlement Class Members Raise Identical, Similar or Related Issues of Law or Fact

11. The Parties propose that the bringing of the class action be authorized for settlement purposes only, without any admission on the part of SeatGeek, on the basis of the following issue of law and fact which is identical, similar or related to the situation of all Settlement Class members:

a) Did SeatGeek's alleged conduct violate s. 54.9.1 of the Consumer Protection Act, and, if so, what is the appropriate remedy?

2- The Facts Alleged Appear to Justify the Conclusions Sought

12. In its Amended Application for Authorization to Institute a Class Action, Plaintiff alleges that Defendant committed a fault, violated the Consumer Protection Act, and engaged in illegal conduct by modifying its "Buyer Guarantee" and Terms of Use and by failing to fully reimburse Quebec residents for all amounts paid before March 11, 2020 for event tickets, which events were subsequently either postponed or rescheduled after March 11, 2020.



13. Plaintiff alleges notably that Defendant violated the *Consumer Protection Act*, as well as the Civil Code of Quebec.

3- The Composition of the Settlement Class Makes it Difficult or Impracticable to Apply the Rules for Mandates to Take Part in Judicial Proceedings on Behalf of Others

- The Settlement Class as provided in the Settlement Agreement consists of all persons in Quebec who purchased before March 11, 2020 one or more tickets from SeatGeek for an event scheduled to take place after March 11, 2020, which event was subsequently either postponed or rescheduled, without a full refund being provided by SeatGeek.
- 15. As more fully described in the Settlement Agreement, to be included in the Settlement class, a person should not have already used the ticket to attend the event(s) or received a refund or a credit for such Ticket(s).

4- Plaintiff Patterson is in a Position to Properly Represent the Settlement Class Members

16. Plaintiff Tracy Patterson:

- (a) is a consumer who purchased concert tickets and parking from one of the Defendants to these proceedings (Ticketmaster) for a May 23, 2020 concert event that never occurred;
- (b) gave the mandate to his attorneys to sue many members of the event tickets industry, including SeatGeek, who modified their practices and/or refused to provide timely refunds to consumers who purchased event ticket(s) and other related purchases before March 11, 2020, for event(s) which were either cancelled, postponed or rescheduled because of the Covid-19 pandemic.
- understands the nature of the action and has the capacity and interest to fairly and adequately protect and represent the interests of the Class Members;
- (d) is available to dedicate the time necessary for the present action before the Courts of Quebec and to collaborate with Class Counsel in this regard;
- (e) is ready and available to manage and direct the present action in the interest of the Class Members and is determined to lead the present file until a final



- resolution of the matter, regarding all named Defendants, the whole for the benefit of the Class Members;
- (f) does not have interests that are antagonistic to those of other Class Members;
- (g) has given the mandate to the undersigned attorneys to obtain all relevant information to the present action and intends to keep informed of all developments;
- (h) has given the mandate to the undersigned attorneys to post the present matter on their firm website in order to keep the Class Members informed of the progress of these proceedings and in order to more easily be contacted or consulted by said Class Members;
- is, with the assistance of the undersigned attorneys, ready and available to dedicate the time necessary for this action and to collaborate with other Class Members and to keep them informed;

OPTING OUT OF THE SETTLEMENT CLASS AND OBJECTIONS

- 17. The Parties have agreed that the opt-out period shall be thirty (30) days after the Notice of Approval Hearing is first sent directly to the Settlement Class Members by email and published on the Settlement Website and on Class Counsel website (the "Opt Out Deadline") and to request that no Settlement Class Member be permitted to opt out of this class action after the Opt Out Deadline.
- 18. The Settlement Agreement provides at paragraphs 35 and 42 the procedure for Settlement Class Members to opt out of the Settlement Class and/or object to the Settlement Agreement.
- 19. The Settlement Agreement further provides that any Settlement Class Member who wishes to opt out of to the Settlement Agreement and the Class Action must do so by sending a personally signed written letter which includes the required information and documentation (detailed in the Settlement Agreement) by registered or certified mail to the Clerk of the Superior Court with a copy to Class Counsel so that it is received on or before the Opt-Out Deadline.



20. The Settlement Agreement provides that Settlement Class Members who wish to object to the Settlement Agreement are required to inform Class Counsel in writing of the reasons for their Objection at least five (5) Days before the Approval Hearing, by communicating a document containing the required information (detailed in the Settlement Agreement).

NOTICE OF APPROVAL HEARING

21. The Parties herein have agreed on the form and content of the Notice of Approval Hearing and Short Form Notice of Approval Hearing. Said notices will advise Settlement Class Members of the basic terms of the Settlement Agreement and their right to participate in the settlement approval hearing. The Notice of Approval Hearing and Short Form Notice of Approval Hearing are attached to the Settlement Agreement as Schedules A and B respectively, in both French and English, and are communicated herewith as **Exhibits R-2 and R-3** to this Application.

1- Publication and dissemination of the Notice of the Approval Hearing

- 22. As provided by the Settlement Agreement, the Parties herein have agreed to the publication and the dissemination of the Notice of the Approval Hearing.
- 23. The Settlement Agreement provides that within fifteen (15) days following the Judgment Authorizing the Class Action, the Claims Administrator will send the Notice of the Approval Hearing (in both French and English) to all Group Members to the email address associated with the Group Members' Account using the Detailed List provided by SeatGeek. Should the Claims Administrator receive a Bounce Back, the Claims Administrator will mail the Short Form Notice of the Approval Hearing (in both French and English) to the last postal address associated with the Group Member's Account.
- 24. Furthermore, within twelve (12) Days following the Judgment Authorizing the Class Action the Claims Administrator will create a bilingual Settlement Website containing an electronic version of the Transaction and all relevant schedules and orders.



- 25. Within fifteen (15) Days following the Judgment Authorizing the Class Action, a hyperlink to the Settlement Website will be available on Class Counsel's website (lexgroup.ca).
- 26. In addition to the dissemination of the Notice of the Approval Hearing, copies of the French and English versions of the Notice of the Approval Hearing will also be posted by Class Counsel on the Class Action Registry of the Superior Court of Québec.

2- Settlement Website

- 27. As mentioned above, the Settlement Agreement provides that a fully bilingual Settlement Website will be available to Settlement Class Members twelve (12) days following the Judgment Authorizing the Class Action.
- 28. As stated in the Settlement Agreement, the functionality of the Settlement Website will include, but not be limited, to posting French and English copies of the Settlement Agreement and of the Notice of the Approval Hearing, the relevant deadlines applicable, a toll-free telephone number and addresses to contact the Claims Administrator by email and mail.

THE CLAIMS ADMINISTRATOR

- 29. The Parties herein seek the appointment of Velvet Payments Inc. ("Velvet") to serve as Claims Administrator.
- 30. The Settlement Agreement stipulates that the Parties agree that Velvet shall serve as Claims Administrator, subject to approval by the Court, and that SeatGeek will pay the costs of notice and administration regardless of whether the Settlement Agreement is ultimately approved.
- 31. The parties' attorneys are aware of the resources and abilities of Velvet generally.
- 32. Velvet has also served as notices and/or claims administrator in the context of other consumer protection class actions in Quebec, including cases involving



event tickets compagnies, namely in the case Abihsira v. StubHub inc. et al. (500-06-000754-156).

33. The Parties recommend to the Court that Velvet Payments Inc. be appointed Claims Administrator.
